

Colonial Coal up 26% with strong volume

The stock rose 26% on the day, with heavy volume of 293,000 shares traded, and no news released.

With around 700 million tons of premium hard coking coal, in

the best jurisdiction, Canada, Colonial's market cap of around CAD\$ 45 million looks extremely undervalued given the asset value.

At around 50c per ton, the assets are worth CAD \$350 million, or around CAD\$2 per share, making the current 33.5 cents price looks extremely undervalued in my opinion.
