

New crypto Exchange heist, \$32 million stolen from Bitpoint

Japanese based crypto Exchange Bitpoint has reported a \$32 million theft.

Hackers stole Bitcoin ([BTC](#)), Litecoin ([LTC](#)), Ether ([ETH](#)) and [XRP](#) from the exchange's hot wallets.

Japanese based crypto Wxchange Bitpoint has reported a \$32 million theft.

Hackers stole Bitcoin ([BTC](#)), Litecoin ([LTC](#)), Ether ([ETH](#)) and [XRP](#) from the exchange's hot wallets.

Bitpoint suspended all services following the hack, while the exchange's parent firm Remixpoint Inc. shed 19% following the theft. Remixpoint went untraded in Tokyo following the attack due to a reported glut of sell orders.

The recent incident involving Bitpoint follows a record-breaking hack of Japanese exchange Coincheck in January 2018, when \$534 million of NEM tokens were stolen.
